REQUIREMENTS & ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS FOR AN APPRENTICE

REQUIREMENTS

- MUST BE 18 YEARS OLD AT START OF CLASS AND HAVE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR GED.

SKILLS

- Using mathematics to solve problems.
- Understanding written sentences and paragraphs in work related documents.
- Using scientific rules and methods.

ABILITIES

- The ability to quickly move your hand, your hand together with your arm or your two hands to grasp, manipulate or assemble objects.
- The ability to tell when something is wrong or something is likely to go wrong. It does not involve solving the problem only recognizing there is a problem.
- The ability to match or detect differences between colors, including shades of color and brightness.
- The ability to read and understand information and ideas presented in writing.
- The ability to arrange things or actions in a certain order or pattern according to a specific rule or set of rules (e.g., patterns of numbers, letter, words, pictures, mathematical operations).

WORK ACTIVITIES

- Using hands and arms in handling, installing, positioning, and moving materials, and manipulating things.
- Observing, receiving, and otherwise obtaining information from all relevant sources.
- Monitoring and reviewing information from materials, events, or the environment, to detect or assess problems.
- Performing physical activities that require considerable use of your arms and legs and moving your whole body, such as climbing, lifting, climbing while lifting, balancing, walking, stooping, and handling of materials.

- Identifying information by categorizing, estimating, recognizing differences or similarities, and detecting changes in circumstances or events.

WORK CONTEXT

- This job will require using your hands to handle, control, or feel objects, tools, or controls.
- This job will require working indoors in environmentally controlled condition, and outdoors in the elements, in uncontrolled conditions.
